We will start making the changes on **Monday 1 June 2026.**

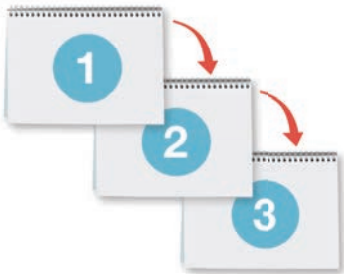


We hope it will be finished in 2028.

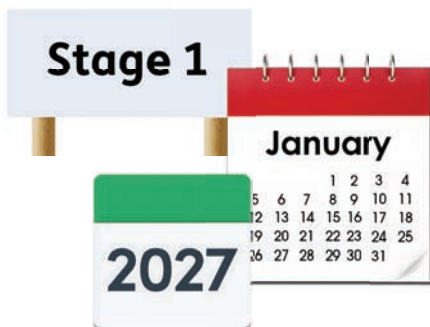
Changes we are going to make



We will have to close parts of the bus station while we make the changes.



The changes will happen in stages.



The changes in stage 1 will last until January 2027.



The changes in this stage will be:



Outside the bus station

Parts of Macaulay Square will be closed.



This change will start on **Monday 1 June 2026.**

Changes to where coaches will stop



Coaches will not stop at the bus station while we are making the changes.



They will stop on Westgate instead.



This change will start on **Monday 1 June 2026.**



The entrance

The **entrance** is the way in to the station.



The entrance on Henry Street will be closed.



To get into or out of the bus station, you will need to use the main entrance.



Or you could use the side entrance on Market Street.



This change will start on **Sunday 14 June 2026.**

Changes to bus stands



We need to make some changes to **bus stands** while we do the work at the bus station.

Bus stands are bus stops at the bus station.



Closed

The changes we will make are:

Some bus stands will close.

Stand M

Stand E

Closed



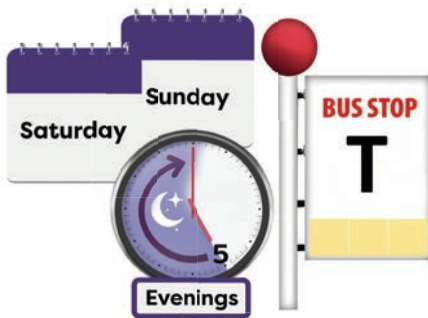
Most buses will stop at a different stand to normal.



Some buses will stop on the street outside the bus station.



Some buses will stop at 1 stand most of the time.



But sometimes, they will stop at different stands. This might be in the evenings or at weekends.



These changes will start on **Sunday 14 June 2026.**

The Travel Centre and the toilets

The **Travel Centre** is where you can find information to help you plan your journey.



You can also buy bus tickets at the Travel Centre.



The Travel Centre and the toilets are going to move.



They will be in cabins in Macaulay Square.



The toilets will move on **Thursday 6 August 2026.**



The Travel centre will move on **Saturday 22 August 2026.**

Things you need to find out when you plan your journey



The number of the bus you want to catch.



Where to catch your bus. This might be at the bus station or on a street outside the bus station.



What time you need to catch your bus.



You need to check if your bus changes where it stops at some times.

Remember, the Travel Centre will move to a cabin on Macauley Square from **Saturday 22 August 2026**.



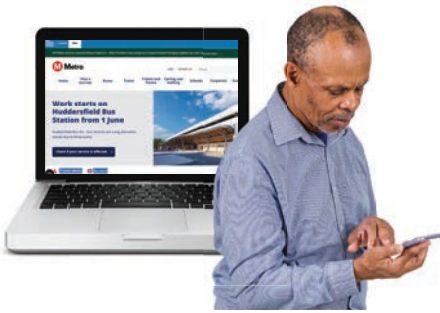
