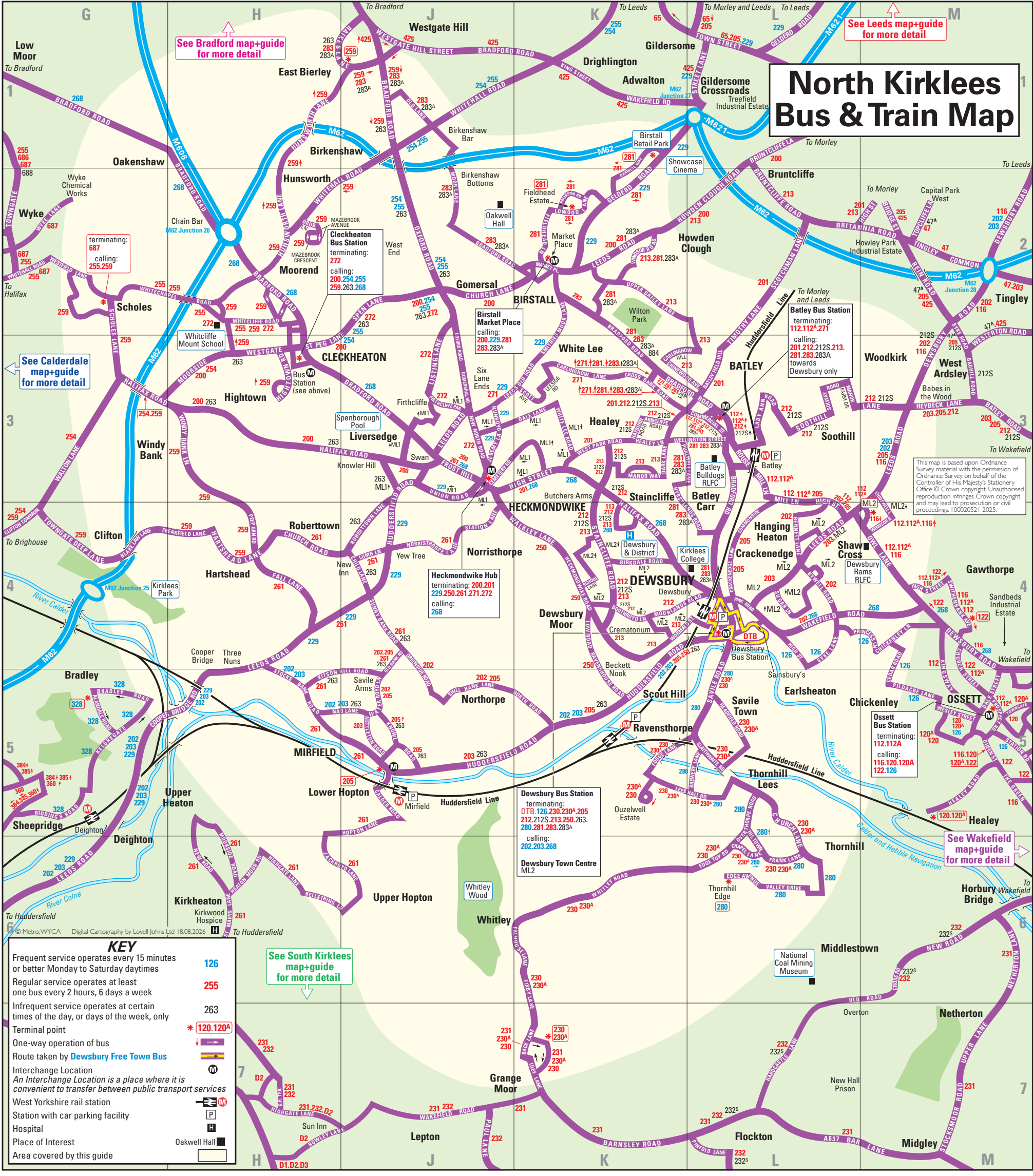




North Kirklees Bus & Train Map
